The mission of the *Young At Art* (YAA) Exhibition is to showcase the creativity of children by giving them the opportunity to hang and view their works, and those of their contemporaries, in a museum setting. YAA broadens students' perspectives on the creative process and raises awareness of the role of the arts in advancing learning. The **Mystic Museum of Art (MMoA)** is committed to education and to the enrichment of children's lives.

Awards & Categories: First Prize Winners in both 2-D and 3-D, and winners of the Lil Maxwell Award in each of the three grade categories (Pre-K-4, 5-8, and 9-12) will receive Gift Certificates toward a studio class of their choosing at MMoA. Certificates will be awarded for Second Prize, Third Prize, Honorable Mention, and Group Prizes in each grade category.

Requirements and conditions: Artwork may be submitted by individuals or through a teacher or school, but is strictly limited to one (1) submission per artist to guarantee wall space for everyone. Teachers are limited to 15 pieces of student artwork per teacher. *If more than one teacher per school submits artwork, it is the teachers' responsibility to ensure they do not submit more than one work by any individual. Should MMoA receive more than one work by any individual, exhibition staff will select the artwork to be displayed.* All artwork must be delivered to MMoA on March 10th or March 11th between 11am and 5pm.

Artwork may not exceed 48" in any direction or 30 lbs. Charcoals and pastels must be sprayed with fixative, and all work to be hung on walls must be either matted or framed, and wired or otherwise ready to hang. MMoA cannot accept art requiring electricity or art that includes living plants, animals, or perishables. MMoA reserves the right to eliminate any artwork for exhibition. Submission of entry gives the exhibition sponsors and MMoA the right to reproduce and publish slides and photographs of artwork solely for promotional purposes, with all proper credit given to the artist.

Instructions: Download entry forms and labels at mysticmuseumofart.org/young-at-art-6. If an artwork is for sale, please list the artist's address (**not** the school's address) to ensure accurate delivery of commission checks. YAA artists receive 100% of sales.

Artwork must be picked up on April 14 or 15 unless prior arrangements are made with MMoA. Storage space is limited. After June 30, unclaimed artwork will be disposed of at the museum's discretion.
