The mission of the Young At Art (YAA) Exhibition is to showcase the creativity of children by giving them the opportunity to hang and view their works, and those of their contemporaries, in a museum setting. YAA broadens students' perspectives on the creative process and raises awareness of the role of the arts in advancing learning. The **Mystic Museum of Art (MMoA)** is committed to education and to the enrichment of children's lives.

AWARDS & CATEGORIES: Awards are given in 2-D and 3-D categories in three age brackets (Pre-K – 4th Grade, 5th – 8th Grade, and 9th – 12th Grade). First, Second, Third, Lil Maxwell, and Honorable Mention Winners will receive MMoA Gift Certificates towards (1) free 2020 studio class of their choice. Group Prize-winning teachers may coordinate with MMoA for either (1) free field trip to the Museum or (1) free hour-long outreach program.

REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS: Artwork may be submitted by individuals or through a teacher or school, but is strictly limited to one (1) submission per artist to guarantee wall space for everyone. Teachers are limited to 15 pieces of student artwork per teacher. *If more than one teacher per school submits artwork, it is the teachers' responsibility to ensure they do not submit more than one work by any individual. Should MMoA receive more than one work by any individual, exhibition staff will select the artwork to be displayed.* All artwork must be delivered to MMoA on April 24 or April 25 between Noon and 4:30pm (MMoA's doors lock exactly at 5pm).

Artwork may not exceed 48" in any direction or weigh more than 30 lbs. Charcoals and pastels **must** be sprayed with fixative. **All 2-D artwork must be either matted or framed, and ready to hang.** Young artists and/or teachers **must** apply low-impact hanging material such as Command Strips or similar (such as material used to hang posters in college dorm rooms) for any work not wired for hanging. MMoA cannot accept art requiring electricity or art that includes living plants, animals, or perishables. MMoA reserves the right to exclude any artwork for exhibition. Submission of entry gives the exhibition sponsors and MMoA the right to reproduce and publish slides and photographs of artwork solely for promotional purposes, with all proper credit given to the artist.

MMoA is unable to accommodate any late pick-up this year.
